Copyright Law for Artists

As artists, we all have to be aware of copyright laws. If we sell our work or enter it in club events, we don't want to be guilty of copying someone else's work. When we create work we want to protect it from being copied illegally by others. As a club we also have to be aware of copyright rules in order to avoid breaking the law when we host shows or galleries. If you need more information about copyright law for artists, there are many helpful sights on the internet. More examples of these will be provided at the February business meeting. EUSTIS ART LEAGUE STANDING RULES 12.29.09

The Eustis Art League defines "original art work" as follows: **All work must be the original work of the artist submitting the piece. Work borrowed from magazine pages (in whole or bits and pieces) is not acceptable, nor is another's photography (published or otherwise) which has been used to draw, paint, or create. Copying, emulating or painting in the style of another artist is not acceptable. Images downloaded from the Internet are not acceptable.**

This rule applies to all shows, galleries and activities organized the Eustis Art league.
