I'd like to congratulate our members on a very successful show again this year. We had 59 entries from 25 different members. We awarded 24 ribbons and gave out \$715 dollars in prizes. We were able to increase our prize money this year thanks to our prize sponsors: The Conger-Miranda Financial Consulting Group – Best of Show, DK Art Supplies – 1st prize Abstract, The Village Framers – 1st prize Still Life and Floral, and All About Images – 1st prize Photography. Our silent auction table netted \$438 dollars. This helped us balance our show budget.

We were also able to display 25 samples of art work created by students of Eustis Middle School. This was a wonderful way to reach out to the community at large and encourage artists who may become future art league members.
