## Art Tips

A brush holder can be made of PVC pipe. The base is a 3" pvc drain while the top piece is 3" pvc pipe. Cut the pipe piece at an angle to facilitate access to smaller brushes.

Ever had a problem unscrewing a cap from a paint tube? Save your toothpaste caps. Clean them up and replace the small paint cap with a toothpaste cap. The toothpaste caps don't have to be unscrewed to deliver pigments.
