Jan will demonstrate various techniques that she uses with with Alcohol Ink, that new medium you've heard about! Learn to loosen up, and go with the flow. Let the inks do most of the work for you. She will follow this with a 3 hour, hands on workshop on November 21st at LEMA from 1:30 to 4:30 p.m.

Bring a round or flat synthetic brush, any size between 8-12. A cheap brush is best, as it might get stained; otherwise, there is no damage.
