This category will be open to paintings or drawings showing historical scenes or buildings from the history of Eustis. You might want to try a painting of the Alice B. McClelland Memorial Bandshell for the "Historical Eustis" category in next year's show. It was built in 1926. It is one of the two remaining historic bandshells in Florida. The Alice B. McClelland Memorial Bandshell is listed in the National Register of Historic Places. (Local Landmark status granted 2010)
